



Night 1 ACTIVITIES: Monday, June 15

Kids Week 2020: Raccoon Ridge Family Camp-IN!

SUPPLIES NEEDED: All Supplies are optional! The Virtual Family Kids Week Experience will be on LCC.TV from 6:30-7:30pm. Tune in a few minutes early!

These Family Activities provided are **OPTIONAL** for 7:30pm & beyond. This is designed for your family, however it may look, to do TOGETHER! It is FUN and INTERACTIVE for everyone who participates! You can do as much/little as what works for your family. Most supplies you will probably have at your house, but a few you will have to plan for!

FAMILY ACTIVITY #1: CAMP-IN!

FAMILY CAMPFIRE TIME!

This time is designed to engage kids regarding what they just heard on Night 1! Feel free to go through these questions, eat a snack provided by us, and do the visual activity together! *Bonus:* You can build a tent in your backyard, a fort in your house, or cozy up under some blankets as a fun place to do these activities!

Family Discussion Questions: (Eat your Gold Fish/Swedish Fish as you talk through these!)

- Talk about a time you were really hungry!
- Tell about a time that God met a need for you!
- Are there any needs you can trust God for this week?

ADULT SAY: God wants us to talk to Him about our needs. He wants us to realize our deep need for Him. Often, He will provide for our deepest needs and hungers to make us realize we can't do it without Him. Often, we forget How much we need Him.

- Where does our food come from? Our water? Our Shelter? Even the air we breathe.

ADULT SAY: Yes, it ALL comes from God! Sometimes we take these things for granted...let's not do that. Let's take a minute to thank God for 5 things in our life right now!

Visual Connection Activity: (*Supplies Needed:* Paper for child and adult and scissors)

The goal of this activity is to explain the story of Jesus feeding thousands with bread and fish.

ADULT SAY: How many corners does your piece of paper have? (*Give kids time to answer*)

ADULT SAY: Yes, your paper has 4 corners. But what if I want to give someone a corner? *(Cut off a corner of the paper, and hand it to a child.)* Hold up paper and **say:** Now that I've given a corner away, how many corners do I have? *(Give kids time to answer.)* **say:** Wait a minute. I have five. *(Count the corners to the kids. Then have each child cut a corner from their paper.)*

ADULT SAY: You see, the more times Jesus divided the bread and fish, the more He had to give away. Not only that but the people had more than enough. *(Keep cutting corners and counting corners.)*

More Family Discussion Q's:

- What surprised you about our activity?
- Which things amazed and surprised you about what Jesus did?
- What is our Kids Week Memory Verse? Yes, Matthew 5:16 Let's say it together! " Let your light shine before others, so that they may see your good works and give glory to your Father who is in heaven."

ADULT SAY: God wants us to shine our lights so others may know Jesus, just like the boy did with his shared food.

- What is something you give that God could use to help others?

ADULT SAY: Jesus took a boy's lunch and blessed 5000 people with it. He can do the same thing with us! He can take what we have and bless others with it. We just have to trust God to provide, and Jesus just might use what we already have to do it.
